# **Bloxham Primary School Service Child Report 2022-2023**

Service pupil premium is equal to £320 per pupil per year.

There are 5 pupils in receipt of this: 2 x YR, 2x Y2 and 1x Y5.

Child A: 94.8%

\*Child D: 93.7%

Child E: 97.1%

## Average: 95.6%

\*The lowest, child D, had two bouts of illness in the Autumn and Spring terms. This figure has increased to 97.9% from April 2023 – July 2023.

## **Attainment:**

Service Pupil Premium is not linked to academic attainment but is for pastoral support:

#### From Gov.uk:

The purpose of the Service pupil premium

Eligible schools receive the SPP so that they can offer mainly pastoral support during challenging times and to help mitigate the negative impact on Service children of family mobility or parental deployment.

Mobility is when a Service family is posted from one location to another, including overseas and within the UK.

## Interventions:

All pupils have access to the Robin Room (nurture room) whether on a 1-1 or group basis, or to access this provision at breaks and lunch times.

# **Specific additional costs:**

One pupil in year 5 received a 50% discount on the school residential trip to Osmington Bay, paying £150 instead of £300.
