What is Maths Flex? How does it work?

Maths Flex is a KS2 home learning program designed to match the Power Maths learning your child will be doing in school. Maths Flex is a personalised KS2 maths practice service, which combines a small steps teaching approach while adapting to your child's own strengths and weaknesses.

Using Maths Flex at home

Each child has a unique homepage and can log into it by following these steps:

1. Go to www.activelearnprimary.co.uk
2. Enter the login details.
3. Your child's homepage will appear.
4. Go to "My Stuff" and click on "Maths Flex"
5. A new tab will appear with activities for you to complete with your child

How does Maths Flex work?

Maths Flex is based on a 'small-steps' approach, sometimes called a mastery approach. This means that the concepts are broken down so that your child can master one idea at a time without feeling overwhelmed. There are a range of fluency, reasoning and problem solving questions in each small step that are designed to support learners' different needs and confidence levels.
