Important reminders:


Friday is phonics book change day.

Maths

At the start of this term we will be working on naming 2D and 3D shapes as well sorting these and making patterns. We will then be learning about numbers within 20 and using this knowledge to add and subtract. To support our learning, we will continue to use part whole models, tens frames and number lines.

English

The children will continue to access grouped phonics to develop their reading skills. They will take home books linked to their phonics learning every Friday. We will also be sending out phonics videos to support your child's learning.

In Writing we will be reading the story The Queen's Hat. We will be developing our vocabulary and sentence writing skills. Using these we will be writing our own adventure stories!

Creative Curriculum

To start the term off we will be heading on a Virtual Trip to London on 9th January to start our Bright Lights, Big City learning. This will incorporate both History and Geography learning. We will be covering Human Senses in Science and developing our Art skills through our Rain and Sunrays topic.

Computing

This term in Computing we will be learning some early programming skills to move a robot. We will discover and learn about commands as well as make predictions about how robots may move.

PSHE



Our PSHE learning will be based around Dreams and Goals. The children will be considering what their hopes and dreams are for the future and making small goals that they can work towards. We will continue to use the zones of regulation to support the children's emotional vocabulary.




