Kevin Moyes – Chair of Governors

Governor Type: Local Authority Governor

Term of Office Ends: 20th February 2027

Other Roles: Whistleblowing Link Governor, GDPR Governor, Chair of Headteacher Performance Committee and Pay Panel, Finance Lead Governor and Premises and Health and Safety Lead Governor



Kevin has been a governor since 2012, he is currently the Chair of Governors Five Acres Primary School in Bicester and Gateway Primary School in Carterton. Kevin has been the Chair of Governors at 10 primary schools in Oxford including chairing four Interim Executive Boards; the first where the school moved from Requires Improvement to Good and the others where the school moved to Requires Improvement during Kevin's time there. Kevin carries out governor training, mentors Chairs of Governors and undertakes external governance reviews for Oxfordshire's Governor Services. Kevin has been a Trustee for a Multi-Academy

Trustee and is a reserve member of the Oxfordshire Schools' Forum and the Oxfordshire Governors' Association. Kevin became a governor because he had a very poor primary school education (because he is neurodiverse, but it was not diagnosed in childhood) and he wanted to ensure that other children did not have the same experience, because he knows first-hand the challenges this creates. Kevin's is in an Executive role as Chief People Officer for an international ocean conservation charity, a role which requires a focus on professional organisational governance, culture and effectiveness. Kevin lives in Abingdon with his wife and two daughters.
