- Ensure my child wears the correct uniform and brings their PE kit to school where necessary.
- Support school values, to make sure my child maintains a consistently high standard of behaviour.
- Encourage my child to try their best.
- Communicate information to the school, which may affect my child's behaviour or learning.
- Follow the school communication structure and communicate respectfully with the school.
- Communicate with staff during core school hours, understanding that although I may receive a response outside of those hours, I should not expect this.
- Support my child to complete home learning on time and alert teachers of any issues.
- Read and follow the school's policies.
- Support my child to bring any requested/required equipment.
- Treat all members of the school community with care and respect.
- Engage in parent meetings and work with the school to achieve the best outcomes for my child.
- Read all communications sent home by the school and respond where necessary.

As a pupil, I will do my best to:

- Arrive at school on time and ready to learn.
- Try my best to do my work and ask for help if I need it.
- Wear the correct school uniform and bring my PE kit to school when I need it.
- Be friendly and caring towards other children and adults.
- Listen to instructions from the adults at school, follow the school rules and uphold the school values.
- Do my home learning and bring it back to school on time.
- Look after the school equipment and be respectful of the school environment.
