We use both our in and outdoor space to engage children's curiosity, develop key life skills and promote positive relationships.

We understand that not all children learn in the same way or at the same pace and plan accordingly.

Through observations and interactions we build a holistic picture of each child and can use this invaluable information to plan for each individual's learning journey.



Through a mix of adult led, small group and independent activities, children make fantastic progress across all areas of the Early Years Curriculum.





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## Our Outdoor Learning Environment



We are very lucky to have a fantastic outdoor space which is shared between Pre-School and Foundation classes.



We ensure children are able to access a wide variety of activities each week whilst outside. This includes activities to promote Physical development, fine motor and gross motor skills.



We ensure that our outdoor provision incorporates all areas of the Curriculum. Opportunities to write, count, reason, turn take and to develop communication and personal skills are planned for independent learning and focused activities.
