Why 'Teach Computing' at Bloxham C of E Primary School?

Teach Computing was chosen to deliver our Computing Curriculum because it offers a broad curriculum, encompassing different units to suit a range of skill sets. It encourages the use of different software, exposing children to a range of technology which will support them in our ever-evolving World. The spiral curriculum allows children to revisit the different units and build upon skills throughout their primary school journey.

E-Safety is at the heart of Teach Computing and intertwines different elements of E-Safety within each unit, teaching children the importance of using technology safely. We also use Project Evolve for our stand-alone E-Safety lessons once a term. Project Evolve has eight strands which enables teachers to choose from a range of themes and respond to the needs of their classes at the time. Teach Computing is used by some of the local secondary schools, allowing good continuation for the children and also allowing our Computing Lead to work closely with other local professionals. Teach Computing offers different CPD programmes for both Teachers and the Computing Lead, enabling us to broaden our skill set and increase confidence in delivery. Teach Computing is an inclusive curriculum which encourages children from all backgrounds to thrive. Their 'I Belong' programme is one example of how they do this and is one programme we have utilised at Bloxham C of E Primary School.
