

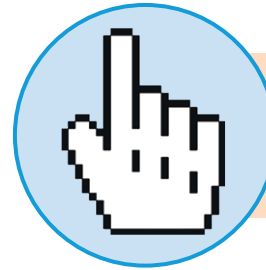
# Protect Yourself from Online Scams

**Never share personal information,** financial details or passwords in response to an email, gaming chat or text message.



**Think before you click.** Only open attachments and emails from known and trusted sources.

Update your **privacy settings** on apps, games and websites.

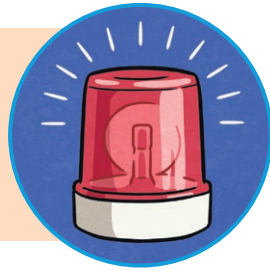


Beware of copycat web addresses. Look for the padlock and use websites that start with **https://**

The S stands for SECURE!

Scams are less likely on these sites but still possible.

**Be sceptical.** If something seems too good to be true, it probably is!



If you're ever worried, upset or confused by anything you see online, **ask a trusted adult** for help.



Use **strong passwords** and change them regularly. Include a mix of upper and lowercase letters, numbers and symbols.



Keep your **antivirus software** updated.
