Home Learning continued . . .

Reading - We ask that your child reads every day. To support your child's reading, they will bring home their reading book and reading record. Please bring them back to school every day so we can hear them read in school.

Maths Flex – To support your child's Maths learning, we will set weekly maths tasks which link to our classroom learning. We ask for at least 30 minutes per week. We will also be introducing weekly maths homework that will need to be completed and returned to school.

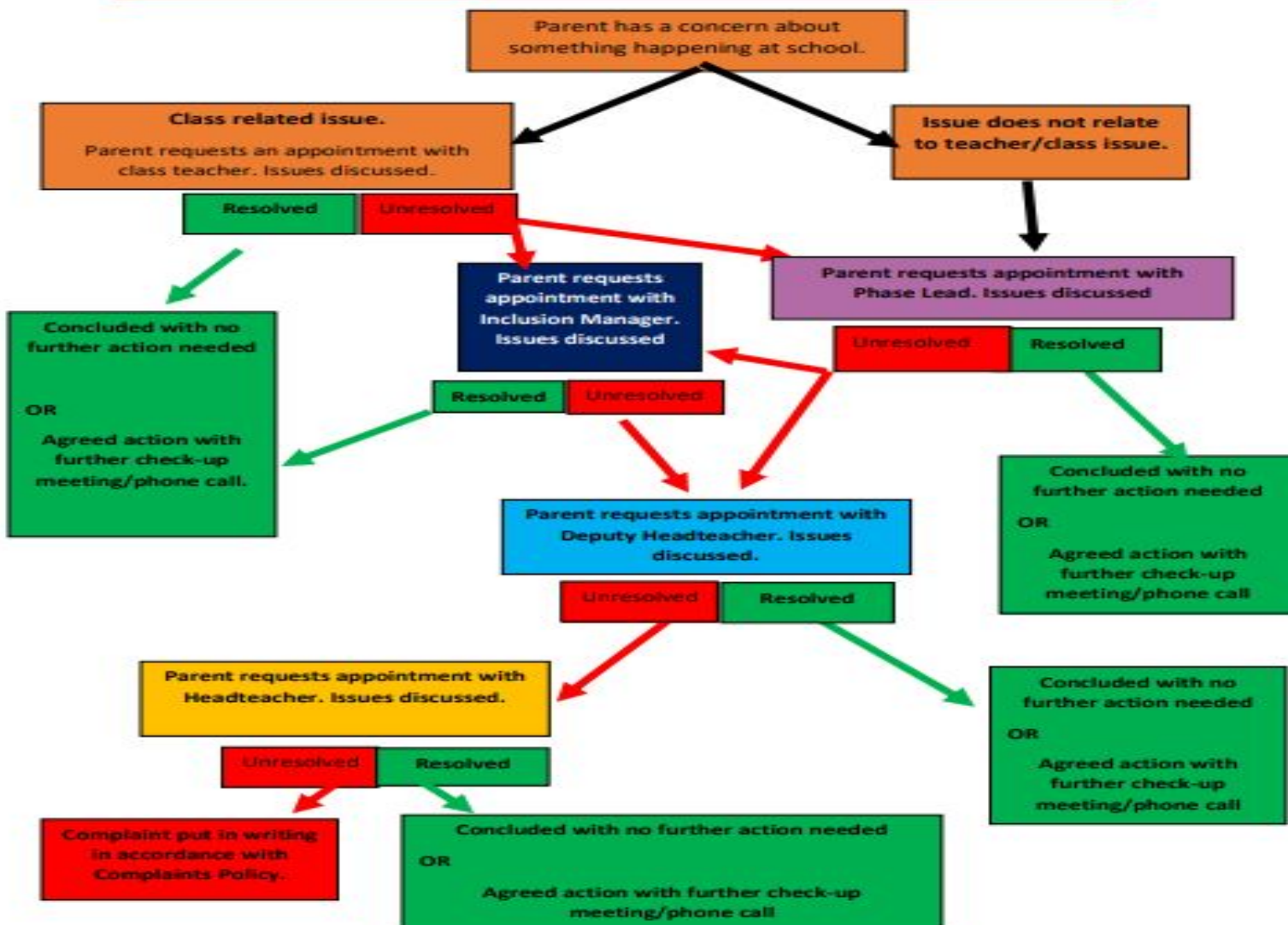
